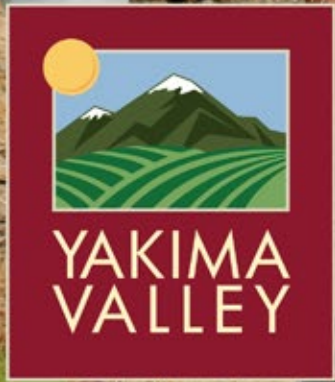
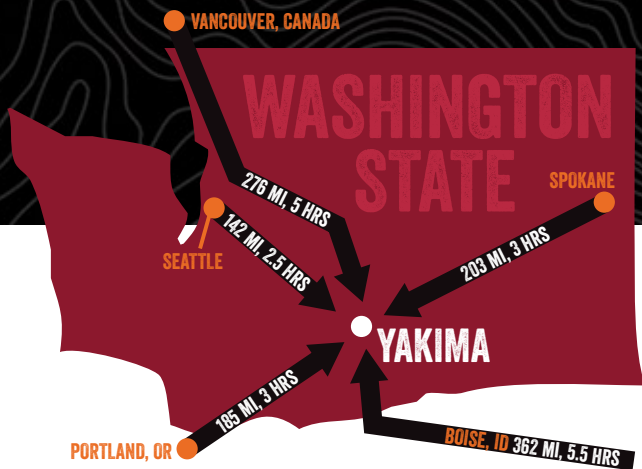
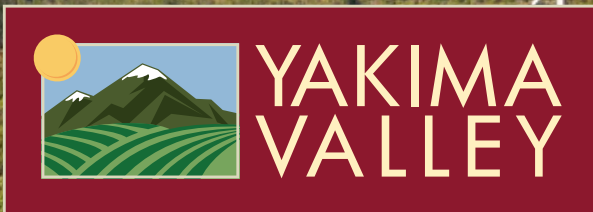

Where you can hit the trails and waterways with plenty of time to go wine and beer tasting



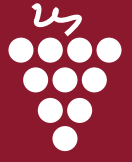
HOPS & CRAFT BEER

COME RAISE A PINT IN THE HOME OF THE HOPS

As one of the world's largest hop producing regions, we like to say we grow your beer! Yakima Valley hop growers keep the beer industry brewing but it's the Valley's craft beer scene that's hopping! Our brewers and hop growers rub shoulders in the field and in the taproom, so innovation to produce experimental hops fuels creativity in the breweries. Take a tour of more than 20 breweries, tap houses and distilleries on the Yakima Valley Craft Beer Trail, just minutes or even steps from where the hops are harvested. After 30 crazy days of hop harvest in September, it all culminates with the Yakima Valley's signature Fresh Hop Ale Festival, one of the "Top 10 Beer Festivals in The Nation!"

OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

GET OUTSIDE UNDER SUNNY SKIES

The Yakima Valley is where find outdoor adventures in every direction. You can hike, mountain bike, float the Yakima River, fish on Washington's only blue ribbon trout stream, ride the Tieton River rapids, paddle board on Rimrock Lake or area rivers, golf, climb stunning basalt columns and take a horseback ride or cruise on an e-bike through the vineyard all in a weekend. More than 300 miles of trails promise adventures for all abilities. Sign up for bike rides and runs from April to November. In the winter, take advantage of hundreds of miles of groomed snowmobile trails, ski, snowshoe and more! The best part? It all happens under 300 days of reliably sunny skies.

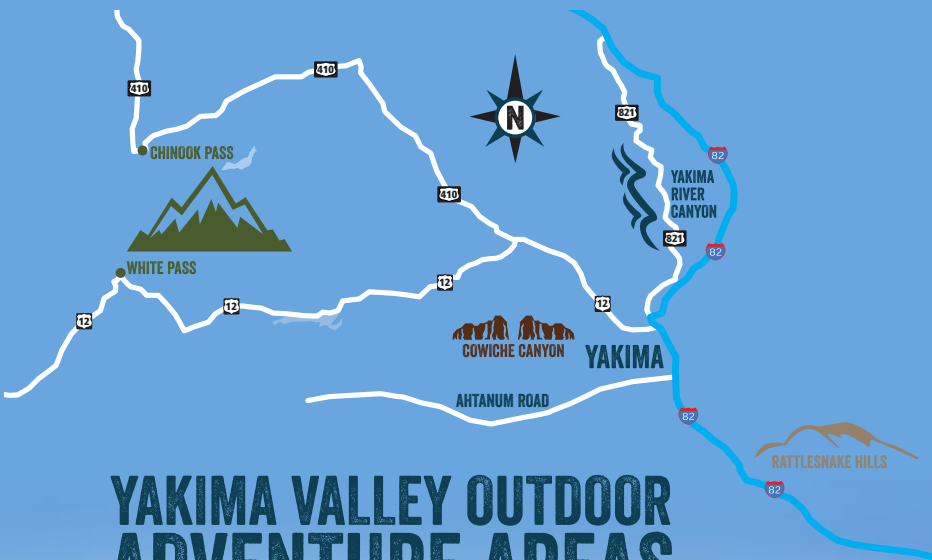
