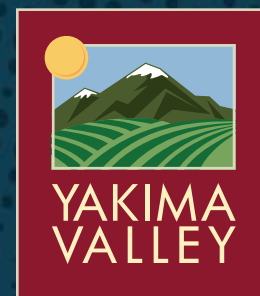

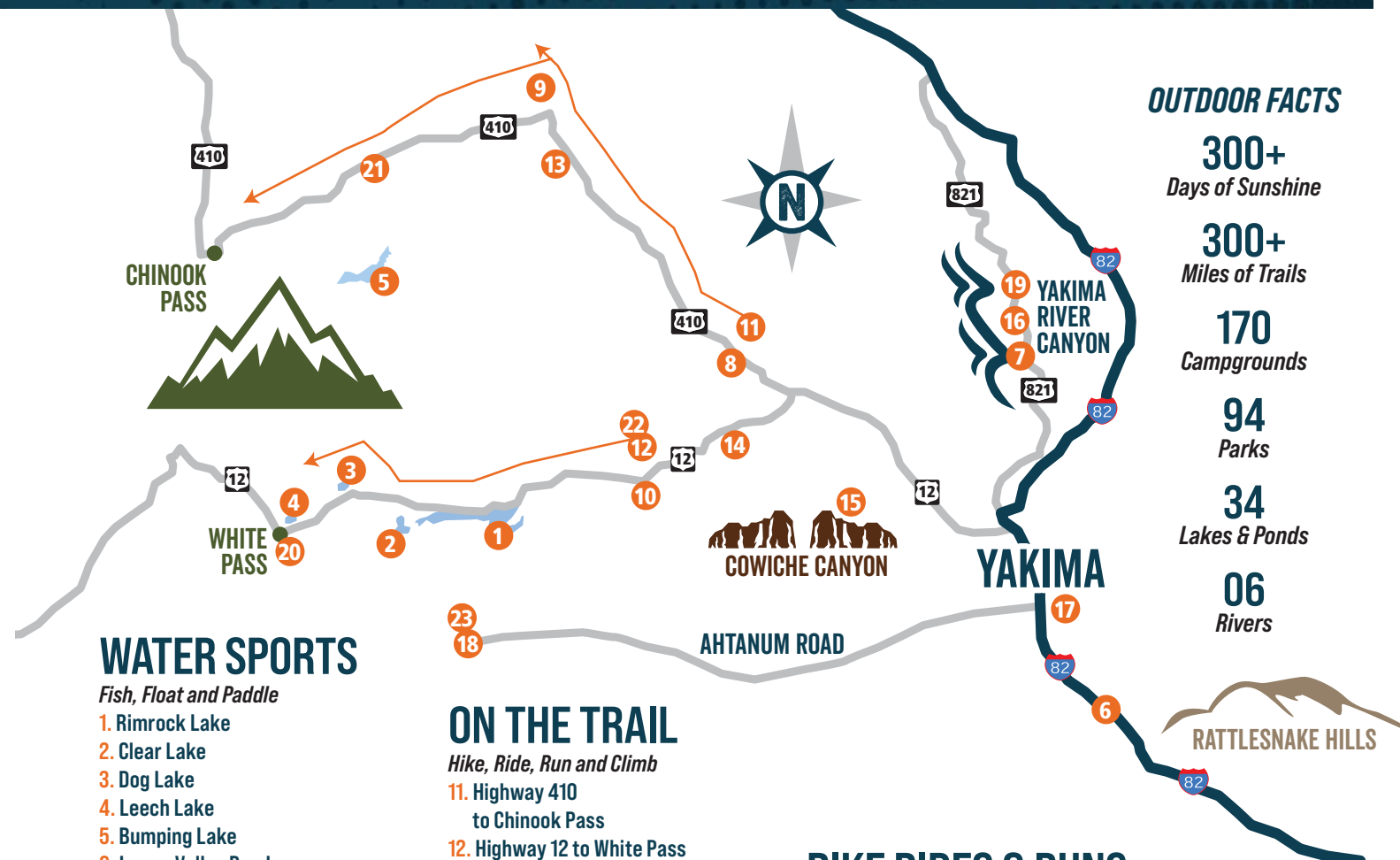

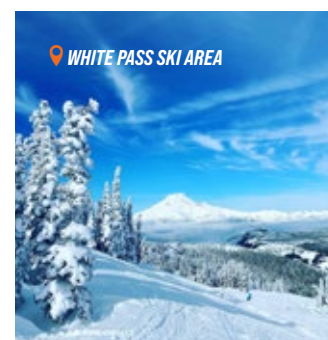

YAKIMA VALLEY WATERWAYS FISH, FLOAT & PADDLE

With the Yakima Valley's reliably sunny skies come summertime highs. Six rivers and dozens of lakes and ponds all around the Yakima Valley mean you'll find plenty of places to keep cool, whether fishing, floating, boating or paddling is your preference.

MOUNTAIN LAKES

Take the short drive from Yakima along Highway 12 or Highway 410 for adventures on pristine mountain lakes with picture-perfect views.

- **Rimrock Lake's** expansive, clear blue waters are easily explored by SUP, kayak or boat. Anglers find kokanee and rainbow trout in the cool waters.
- **Clear Lake** is a much smaller, peaceful lake for only non-motorized craft, perfect for learning SUP. Pack a picnic for the day use area. Fishing is open year-round.
- **Bumping Lake** is perfect for a day-long excursion from Yakima. It's a popular place for boating, fishing and paddling, along with trails for hiking, biking and horseback riding.

YAKIMA RIVER

Renowned as Washington State's only blue-ribbon trout stream, the Yakima River is also a popular place for paddling and leisurely floats surrounded by the canyon's dramatic basalt formations.

- Make **Red's Fly Shop** your go-to stop for gear, guided fishing trips, classes and one-of-a-kind River Cruise tours.
- Check out **Rill Adventures** for kayak, SUP and raft rentals, along with guided trips on the Yakima River.
- **Girls with Grit** offers unique SUP clinics on the Yakima River and nearby waterways.



TIETON RIVER

Best known for the Tieton Flip Flop, the river becomes a destination for adventure seekers looking to ride racing rapids every September. That month, when water is released from the Rimrock Lake reservoir, the river transforms into popular class III+ rapids. Contact **Blue Sky Outfitters** to book a trip.



TOP TRAILS FOR SPRING/SUMMER HIKING & BIKING



Explore trails year-round, ranging from the rolling grass and sage-covered plains and hills of the shrub-steppe to dramatic, volcanic formations, subalpine meadows, forested terrain and more. Keep your eyes open for bighorn sheep, elk, raptors and other wildlife.



SPRINGTIME WILDFLOWER HIKES

Enjoy the most blooms from mid-April until late May or early June, with dense carpets of flowers in every color, from bright yellows and shades of orange to a multitude of purples and pinks. Most common wildflowers include balsamroot, lupine, larkspur, purple bitterroot, big head clover, phlox and violets.

- **Snow Mountain Ranch in the Cowiche Canyon Conservancy Trail System** delivers dramatic valley and mountain views.
- **Yakima Skyline Trail** climbs to traverse the rim of the stunning Yakima River Canyon below.
- **Umtanum Creek Trail to Umtanum Ridge** travels through grassy slopes, aspen and willow groves, a dramatic canyon and peaceful meadows.



SUMMER'S PERFECT PICNIC SPOTS

On the Yakima Valley's hot, sunny summer days, begin your hikes and bike rides early in the day and choose trails with shady, picturesque picnic spots.

- **Cowiche Canyon Conservancy East Trail/Winery Hike** winds along Cowiche Creek through the canyon to the winery hike detour. Stroll through the vineyards and then picnic on the grassy lawn of Wilridge Vineyard, Winery & Distillery.
- **Boulder Cave Trail** offers a short, easy hike to the 400-foot-deep Boulder Cave, home to a fragile big-eared bat colony. Picnic at the covered day use area and enjoy the Naches River. *Timed Reservation System*
- **Cleman Mountain/Waterworks Canyon** features two hike options and plenty of picnic spots with valley views.
